Important Terms about China

1. Harmony despite differences

Harmony despite differences is the view of society in Chinese culture. As an old Chinese saying goes, all things breed together without harming each other, and the natural law runs in parallel without contradicting each other. We recognize and respect the differences of all things and seek unity in diversity. Everybody

cherishes his or her own culture, and if we respect and treasure other's culture, the world will be a harmonious one.

2. Harmony Between Man and Nature

Building an ecological civilization is vital to sustaining the Chinese nation's development. It is important to realize that lucid waters and lush mountains are invaluable assets and act on this understanding, implement our fundamental national policy of conserving resources and protecting the environment, and cherish the environment as we cherish our own lives. We will adopt a holistic approach to conserving our mountains, rivers, forests, farmlands, lakes, and grasslands, implement the strictest possible systems for environmental protection, and develop eco-friendly growth models and ways of life. We pursue a model of sustainable development featuring increased production, higher living standards, and healthy ecosystems.

3. Freedom of religious belief

Respect for and protection of freedom of religious belief have been a long term policy of Chinese government in handling religious affairs. As a civil right, freedom of religious belief is guaranteed by the constitution and laws of China. Chinese constitution stipulates that Citizens of the People's Republic of China enjoy freedom of religious belief. No state organ, public organization or individual may compel citizens to believe in, or not to believe in, any religion; nor may they discriminate against citizens who believe in, or do not believe in, any religion. The state protects normal religious activities. No one should make use of religion to engage in activities that disrupt public order, impair the health of citizens or interfere with the educational system of the state. Religious bodies and religious affairs are not subject to any foreign domination.

4. Ethnic Equality and Unity

Irrespective of their size, history, levels of development, customs or religious belief, all ethnic groups in China are equal in every aspect of life. They enjoy the same rights and shoulder the same responsibilities. No discrimination or oppression against any group can be tolerated. Different ethnic groups treat each other as equals and learn from and help each other in a spirit of mutual respect, trust and understanding.
